Scholarships

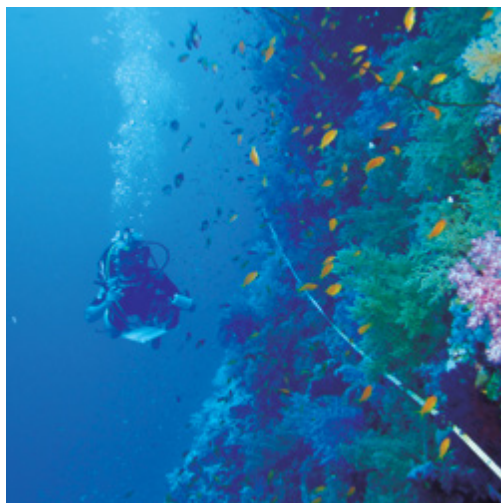
The University of Tasmania offers a range of generous scholarship schemes for both Australian and international students.
