First Year Enrolment Guide

Requirements of the degree

It is important that you understand the requirements of the degree when making decisions. The [Course and Unit Handbook](#) provides you with all the rules and requirements of your degree. You should visit it whenever you're unsure about what options you have.

The Course and Unit Handbook will also show you what you can expect to be studying in your second year in the degree.

First year in the Master of Teaching

The Master of Teaching is a pre-service teaching degree that will give you the skills and knowledge to teach in a primary or secondary school setting. The degree is designed to build upon tertiary qualifications and experience, enabling students to complete a teaching qualification in as little as 2 years. This course is accredited through the Tasmanian Teachers Registration Board, and is recognised in all Australian states and territories.

As a student commencing their Master of Teaching in Semester 1, you will enrol in a total of five units per semester.

One Professional Experience unit which facilitates your placement. These are shown in orange in the diagram to the right. Read more about Professional Experience on their [webpage](#).

Two Core units which are taught into both primary and secondary streams. These are shown in blue in the diagram to the right.

Two Curriculum units which are specific to your stream, and if secondary, your specialisations as per your letter of offer. Specific units can be located on the [Course and Unit Handbook](#). These are shown in green in the diagram to the right.

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Studying part time

If you are planning to study part time, you will enrol in the core units only in your first year. The Professional Experience units require you to have completed the relevant core and curriculum units so that you have the relevant theory knowledge to support you on placement.

Conditional offers

There may have been up to three conditions on your offer letter

- **Completion of the Non-Academic Capability Assessment Tool (NACAT).** Please submit your statement prior to enrolling.
- **Completion of your undergraduate degree.** Your degree must be conferred prior to your commencement in the Master of Teaching
- **Completion of conditional units.** This is for secondary stream only. Your offer letter will specify how many units you are required to study, at what level and in what discipline. Please contact a Course Information Officer through [U Connect](#) to discuss further.

Credit and Advanced Standing

Advanced Standing is only granted in the Master of Teaching on a like for like basis. This means that we are looking for the study that you are applying with to:

- Have been completed within five years
- Be accredited at the same level (AQF9) i.e. Master of Teaching study from a different tertiary institution
- Be able to be considered equivalent to a unit in the UTAS MTeach program.

Commencing in Semester 2

For students commencing the course in Semester 2 the minimum completion time is two and a half years. This is due to the timing of and the knowledge you must have gained prior to each Professional Experience. If you are hoping to study full time, the recommended enrolment pattern is below.
